Conflict Minerals Policy

Ref: Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act

In support of the Dodd-Frank Act of 2010 (Section 1502 – “Conflict Minerals”), ITD Precision continues to work with our suppliers to trace raw material content to determine and prevent the usage of minerals originating from mines or uncertified smelting plants located in “Conflict Regions”.

No (3TG) Conflict Minerals originating in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries are used in the production of ITD Precision metal stampings intentionally.

ITD Precision requests its suppliers to submit written conformation (CMRT) as to the origin of mineral contents classified as “3TG” (Tantalum, Tin, Tungsten & Gold)

If any of our suppliers require any 3TG minerals to produce the products supplied to ITD, we ask that they refer to the “Conflict-Free Sourcing Initiative” (CFSI) to determine DRC conflict free sources.
